

CDT 2026 Procedure Code Changes

The American Dental Association (ADA) published the new procedure codes set for 2026. To order, contact the ADA at 800.947.4746 or visit adacatalog.org. Changes in the CDT 2026 include: **31 additions**, **6 deletions**, **14 revisions and 9 editorial actions**. The Code on Dental Procedures and Nomenclature is the national standard for reporting dental services and serves as the HIPAA standard code set. Any claim submitted electronically or on paper must use procedure codes from the current version of the CDT manual.

These guidelines are given as standards of payment and should not be construed as standards of care.

These codes are deleted after 12/31/2025:
