1 - Right Start 4 Kids (RS4K) - The RS4K program provides children 12 and under 100% coverage, with no deductible, for all services covered under the plan, excluding orthodontics, when a Participating Dentist is seen.

2 - Preventive Plus - With Preventive Plus, certain diagnostic and preventive procedure codes do not count toward the patient's overall annual maximum.

3 - Unlimited Cleanings - Patients allowed unlimited cleanings. Covered codes include D1110, D1120 and D4910 (for D4910, previous surgical/non-surgical history is required).

4 - Healthy Benefits - Healthy Benefits allows for enrollees to self-report medical conditions to receive extra cleanings on their dental plan. Medical conditions that can be self-reported include: diagnosed periodontal (gum) disease, pregnancy, diabetes, kidney failure (or undergoing dialysis), and a suppressed immune system (caused by radiation treatment, chemotherapy, HIV, stem cell or bone marrow transplant or an organ transplant).
